Metro Pacific Tollways Ready to Start C-5 Link Expressway

Cavitex Infrastructure Corporation, a member of the Metro Pacific Tollways group of companies, has announced its intention to start work on the C-5 Link Expressway next month. The project is a 9-billion Peso, 7.6 kilometer toll expressway that will link C-5 Road in Taguig to R-1 (Coastal) Expressway presently being operated by Cavitex.

The C-5 Link Expressway is part of the existing concession of Cavitex for the Manila-Cavite Toll Expressway network. The Toll Regulatory Board is required under the concession to issue the notice to proceed with the construction of the project once an independent consulting firm issues a certification under the toll operation agreement on the availability of the right of way for the alignment already approved by DPWH, the approval of a final engineering design now undergoing final review, and construction schedules and costs.

Aside from the approval in principle by the TRB, the project has also received the favorable endorsement of Paranaque City and its barangays, as well as the issuance of the environmental compliance certificate from the DENR. When completed, it will provide relief to traffic congestion in Paranaque City, particularly the residents of Merville, Moonwalk and Multinational villages, and will provide safe, fast and convenient expressway travel for its users in the Cavite, Las Pinas, Paranaque, Taguig, and Makati areas and nearby areas that will benefit from the new expressway.


