Clarification of News Report

We write with respect to the attached article entitled "MWSS penalizes Maynilad for water outages" posted in BusinessMirror (Online Edition) on September 29, 2022. In the said article it was reported in part that:

"The Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System Regulatory Office (MWSS-RO) announced that it has imposed a fine on Maynilad Water Services Inc. due to prolonged and recurring water service interruptions in the southern part of its concession area.

MWSS-RO said in a statement that the water service interruptions as well as water quality issues were monitored from May to July.

'Based on the evidence gathered by the MWSS RO in its investigation into the prevailing water supply conditions in the West Zone, Maynilad Water Services Inc. was found to have breached its service obligation of ensuring the availability of an uninterrupted twenty-four (24) hour supply of water at seven (7) pounds per square inch (psi) minimum pressure for more than 15 days to connected customers in parts of Las Piñas City, Muntinlupa City, Parañaque City, and Cavite Province (Bacoor, Imus, Cavite, Noveleta, and Rosario),' it said.

In light of these findings, the MWSS-RO, through RO Resolution No. 2022-12-CA, has resolved to impose a financial penalty of P9.26 million on Maynilad for the continued water service interruptions within the Putatan Water Treatment Plant supply zone. MWSS said the penalty will be implemented in the form of bill rebates to affected Maynilad customers by November.

We confirm that on September 28, 2022, Maynilad received from MWSS a notice of imposition of penalty in the amount of Php 9.26 Million for water service interruption in Maynilad's concession area. Maynilad has also started implementing mitigating measures to address the situation.

We hope to have clarified the quoted news article in the interest of the trading participants and the investing public.
