Maynilad Water Services, Inc. v. Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, the Pollution Adjudication Board and the Environmental Management Bureau- Regional Directors, G.R. No. 202897

Further to our disclosure dated September 19, 2019, please be informed that Maynilad Water Services, Inc. (“Maynilad”) received the Supreme Court En Banc’s resolution on the Motion for Reconsideration that Maynilad filed on October 2, 2019 (“MR”) in the abovementioned case (the “Resolution”).

Subject of the MR is the Supreme Court’s Decision dated August 6, 2019 which held Maynilad and Manila Water (the “Concessionaires”) liable for fines for violating Sec. 8 in relation to Sec. 28 of the Clean Water Act (“CWA”) (the “Decision”).

The Decision held each of the Concessionaires jointly and severally liable with the MWSS for Php921,464,184.00 for the period from May 7, 2009, the day following the lapse of the five-year period provided in the CWA, to August 6, 2019, the date of the Decision. In the Resolution, the Supreme Court reduced the total amount of the fine to Php202,256,762.22. The Supreme Court considered Maynilad’s good faith and real efforts to comply with the mandate of Section 8 of the CWA and the recent effectivity of Maynilad’s legislative franchise, R.A. 11600, which set to 2037 the attainment of full sewerage and sanitation coverage in its service area.


